



# Jack And The Beanstalk

## Explore the tale

Jack and the Beanstalk is available to listen to on YouTube as well as in PowerPoint format on the school website, under Buttermere in school closure. Can you find Jack? What is he doing? What is going to happen next? Can you re-tell the story? Can you make up a different ending to this traditional tale?

## Make a giant beanstalk

Can you twist bedsheets or towels to make a giant beanstalk? Can you grasp the beanstalk tightly with each hand? What about using both hands together? Hold on tightly and see if you can pull it from a partner.

## Instrument Making

In the story, there's a magic harp which plays music to the giant. Can you make your own instrument using rubbish? Perhaps you can post pasta or rice into an empty bottle to make a maraca? Can you play it loudly to wake a giant in your castle you made? Can you play it quietly to keep the giant asleep?

## Junk Modelling

Can you use some empty boxes to build a castle? How many boxes can you stack? How high is your castle? You could pretend a soft toy is the giant. Ssshhhh, don't wake him! Can you knock your tower down after 3? 1...2....3....argh!
