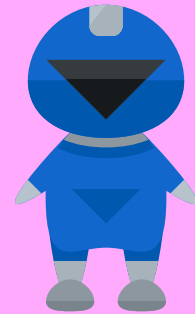


Numeracy - Colour

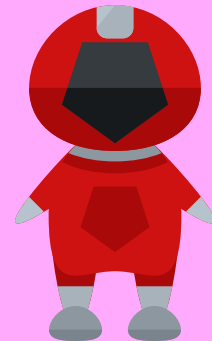
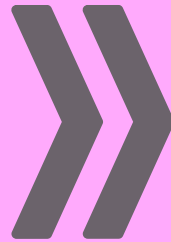
Find all the blue items in your house.

Some children may enjoy exploring and playing with the items first. Count all the items you find. Touch each item as you count.



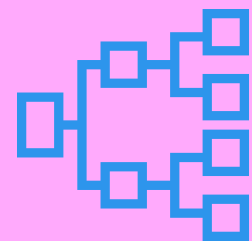
Find all the red items in your house

Name the objects using adjective and noun e.g red sock, red book whilst the child listens. Can they copy your language? Can they copy you doing the Makaton sign? Can they point to the correct symbol? Place one blue and one red item in front of them, can they give you the correct colour when you say 'blue' or 'red'.



Sorting

Mix up all the objects you have found and sort them into red and blue. Some children may need an adult to show them first or to guide their hand in order to sort the colour. Can they sort the colours by themselves?



Make a pattern

Line up the objects to make a pattern e.g red object, blue object, red object, blue object etc.
