Use paint, pencils or crayons and copy an adult to make long strokes down your page to make the tree trunks.

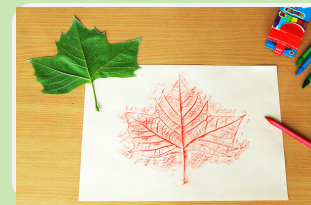
Trace or copy an adult making lots of circular marks to make the leaves at the top.
