



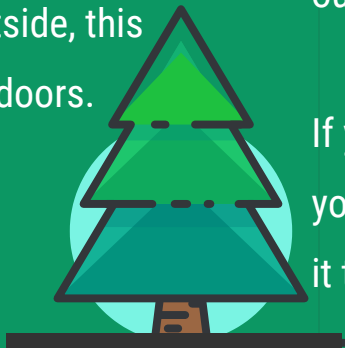

Play Catch

In the story, the Gingerbread Man is chased by lots of different people. Take turns pretending to be the Gingerbread Man. Who is chasing you? Is it the pig? Is it the fox? Can you be caught?

If you can't get outside, this could be played indoors.



Picnic

Follow a breadcrumb trail

Can you pick up a 'breadcrumb' trail from the table?
Can you reach to the left with your right hand? Can you reach to the right with your left hand? Can you drop the crumbs into a container?

If the breadcrumbs are too small, consider using crumpled up paper!

Cookie cutter mark making

Take a gingerbread man cookie cutter (or any biscuit/playdough cutter) and dip in paint. Press down on plain paper to make shapes. Can you choose the next colour? Can you help mix the paint by grasping the paintbrush?
