



# Derwent Easter Activities



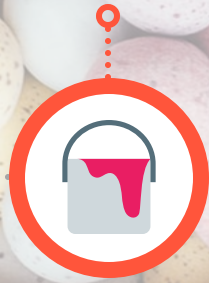
## Natural Easter Egg

Using leaves, flowers, twigs, anything you can find outside, create your own natural Easter Egg. Turn them into decorations, cards or even just temporary works of art.



## Outdoor Egg Art

Definitely one for the outdoors. Fill empty eggshells with paint and create some modern art by throwing them at your paper.



## Egg Decorating

It's an Easter classic! Hard boil some eggs and get decorating. Can you create a scene from your favourite TV programme or try a family portrait?



## Easter Baking

Melt chocolate, syrup and butter. Mix with breakfast cereal and share between cake cases to make Easter nest cakes. Add mini eggs to finish.



## Egg Box Chicks

Cut each egg holder out of the egg box. Place two together to make an oval and glue. Paint and add a beak. Draw on eyes and details when dry. Alternatively, find some pebbles and create some pebble chicks. Can you name them all?



## Easter Games

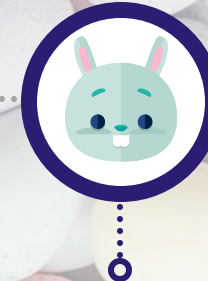
Get moving with some Easter games:
